

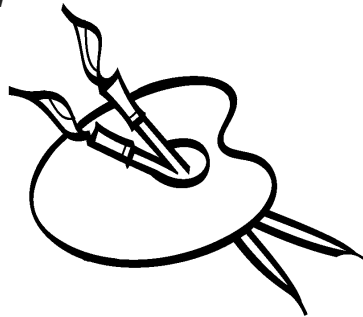

Art & Sculpture

2020 – 2021 Theme: “Rise, and Shine Your Light on Your Revolutionary War Patriot”

All Art and Sculpture entries must be sent to this National Vice Chair with a copy of the signed entry form sent to your State Chair.



There are twelve (12) Art and Sculpture competition categories:

1. Acrylic
2. Pastels
3. Oil
4. Watercolor
5. Drawing (*art pencils-graphite or colored pencil, inks, scratch board*)
6. Multi-media (involves mixing different creative mediums to create work that incorporates two or more art forms such as painting and magazine images, assembled memorabilia, ink and watercolor, etc.)
7. Color Photography (*unenhanced, natural photo*)
8. Color Photography (*computer enhanced photo, and state how the photo was enhanced*)
9. Black and White Photography
10. Sculpture (*any medium that fits the standard for sculpture*)
11. China Painting
12. Other Art and Sculpture

Please review the Craft AND Fiber Arts categories before submitting to Other Art and Sculpture category as the entry may be a better fit in one of those categories.

Please DO NOT send your original artwork.

Photographs should NOT be taken while the art is matted and/or under glass and frame.

- Send THREE (3) photos with your entry—one of the entire art piece, and two zoomed in on details that you would specifically like the judges to see. Send also, a disk or flash

Sculpture: Please include physical photos and digital images that show the different angles and dimensions plus good close details.

Photography: Include a copy of the original photo plus physical photos and digital images that will show good composition of the photograph and clarity, plus dedication to expression of the theme. Computer generated art is unacceptable.

Additional instructions for Art and Sculpture contest entries:

All entries must be the original work created by an individual DAR member or a group of DAR members. It must have been created while they are DAR members and must incorporate the theme **Rise, and Shine Your Light on Your Revolutionary War Patriot.**

- List the dimensions of the artwork on the entry form narrative/paragraph.
- Send entry directly to this National Vice Chair with postmark between January 2, 2021 and February 15, 2021.
- For Group Entries, please refer to **Contest Instructions.**

Judging criteria: (subjective to judges)

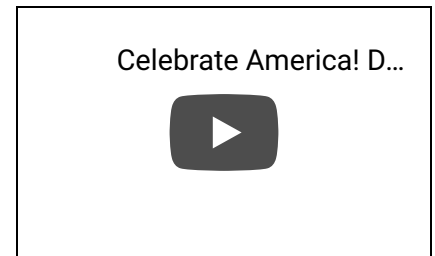
- 50 points - Overall artistic merit
- 20 points - Technical quality
- 20 points - Expression of theme
- 10 points - Uniqueness/Overall impact
